More adventurous types might want to stop by the ejection seat demonstration, and learn how to operate those life-saving devices. Who knows when that skill might come in handy?

With its new Learning Centre, the [Canada Agriculture and Food Museum](#) is now open even during the winter season. Come say hello to the animals as they keep warm inside their barns, or visit the Learning Centre to warm yourself up. If it's the smell of fresh bread that draws you in, make sure to take part in the bread- and butter-making demonstrations, and don't leave before you've had a taste.
